Why HCRW

The proper segregation of HCW at source is an imperative. If proper segregation is not achieved:

- The improper segregation of HCW will pose a health and safety risk to the employees at the healthcare facilities, the patients, waste handlers, cleaners and the public at large.
- The financial implications are huge. 70% - 80% of healthcare facilities waste is domestic waste. If this is not segregated properly it will go for treatment and disposal with the HCW. The cost of treating 1 kg of HCW is much higher than the treatment and disposal of 1 kg of domestic waste.

It has been proved that on-going appropriate awareness and training programmes will ensure proper segregation of HCW and minimize the risk in the workplace
